Tablet PC Input Panel -- Handwriting Recognition

Tablet PC Input panel is available always in the left-side of the windows. While you want to use it , just click the panel and then you can use it freely.



Vista™ introduces intelligent handwriting recognition as a natural supplement to keyboard input. The Handwriting Recognition Personalization Tool provides samples of your writing and increases the probability that your handwriting will be interpreted correctly This new recognition technology efficiently and accurately converts a wide variety of handwriting styles into typed text. With the Handwriting can be used to quickly enter information anywhere that the computer accepts typed input.


Tablet PC Setting

You can find the program to setting up your pen.

Start → control panel → Tablet PC setting →Pen and Input Device

- Flicks are gestures that help you to use your pen more effectively. A quick flick of the pen can scroll a window up or down or navigate forward and backward on the web.
 Flicks can also perform common actions such as copy, paste, delete and undo.
- If you like keyboard shortcuts, you'll probably like customizing pen flicks to perform these





1. Windows Journal:


Microsoft® Journal is an application included in Vista™ that is exclusively for the benefit of users working with a pen tablet, pen display, or Tablet PC. Journal simulates a physical notebook, but with all the advantages of digital Note Taking. You can use it to capture handwritten



notes and drawings, convert handwritten notes to text, import graphics files, and share notes with others You can use a pen in Journal to jot notes and capture quick sketches providing valuable collaboration options for use at home, school, and work. Journal also incorporates a powerful search engine that can even locate handwritten content

2. Stick Notes

You can use the Sticky Notes accessory to write and store short notes, phone numbers, and other reminders. You can place sticky notes directly on your desktop as quick reminders or in any OLE-enabled program, such as Word, to add electronic comments or reminders to your documents



3. Snipping Tool


Use your tablet pen to select a portion of a website, document, or other content on your screen. You can add handwritten comments and then paste it into an e-mail message or other program.




4. More Inking in Office 2007

(A) Microsoft® Word 2007: Path: Review → Start Inking




(B)Microsoft® Excel 2007 Path: Review →Start Inking
